Alexandr L. Khohlov

Alexandr L. Khohlov was born at June 23, 1965. At 1988, he finished his education at General Medicine faculty of Yaroslavl State Medical Institute (now, YSMU) and obtained Medical Diploma with excellence. At 2014, he finished International Institute of Economics and Law with specialization in jurisprudence. Alexandr L. Khohlov has defended successfully his Ph.D. thesis at 1990 (Candidate of Sciences) and at 1998 he defended Doctoral Dissertation (Doctor of Sciences). From that time, he became the professor. From 1999, he got the position of Chair of Department of Clinical Pharmacology. He was Vice-Dean (2005) and Dean of General Medicine Faculty (2006-2011) of our institution, later he was appointed as Assistant of Rector on Innovative Work (2011-2012).

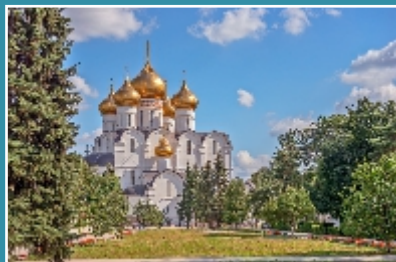

Yaroslavl Oblast (Russian: Яросла́вская о́бласть, romanized: Yaroslavskaya oblast) is a federal subject of Russia (an oblast), which is located in the Central Federal District, surrounded by the Tver, Moscow, Ivanovo, Vladimir, Kostroma, and Vologda oblasts.

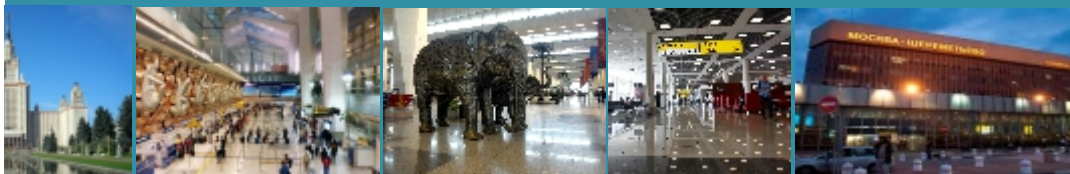


the administrative center of the oblast, is served by major highways, railroads, and waterways. The population of the oblast was 1,272,468 (2010 Census).[8]

Yaroslavl is a Russian city, northeast of Moscow. It's part of the Golden Ring group of ancient towns. On the grounds of the 12th-century Spaso-Preobrazhensky (Savior Transfiguration) Monastery, the golden-domed Transfiguration Church has 16th-century frescoes. Collections at the Yaroslavl Museum-Reserve include 16th- to 18th-century icons. Multicolored glazed tiles cover the Church of the Epiphany's exterior
